The festival will take place on the grounds of the museum and the beautiful Mann-Wagnon Park situated next to the Hillsborough River. We invite artisans, crafters, and entrepreneurs who would like to market and share their talent, innovations, and creativity with the Sulphur Springs and surrounding communities. This opportunity is open to all ages. Application submission deadline is February 14, 2024.

# Application Fee: \$35 for a vendor space. No Fee to apply Online application can be found on our website www.sulphurspringsmuseum.org

There is a limit on the number of vendor spots available and vendors of the same type may need to be limited. The earliest application will receive preference.

Space measures 10ft. x 10ft. Vendor must register directly with the organizer; no sub-leasing. Each vendor operates as an independent agent with no business affiliation with the organizers.

Vendor must provide cords, hoses, adapters, generators, fuel, shelters, tables, chairs, signage, license, permits, insurance, security, and whatever is necessary to operate. Organizer only provides space.

No loud music, illegal drugs, offensive items, or behavior as this is a family-oriented, community event. Organizer reserves the right to revoke permission for vendor to operate.

Cars and tow-vehicles must be removed from museum grounds as soon as unloading is complete to avoid traffic jam.

# **Important Details:**

#### Vendors:

- All vendors are required to arrive at 10:00 am for set-up. **Any vendors who arrive after 10:45am will not be permitted to setup/participate.** Event begins at 11:00 am.
- Complete Set Up by 11:00 am.
- All vendors will be required to park in the designated vendor parking area after setup
- If you have additional people assisting you at your booth, we encourage you and your team to carpool to reduce the number of vehicles on the property in order to allow customers more spaces to park.
- Volunteers may be available to assist with tent setup. Staff/volunteers will not be authorized to unload vehicles or carry any items to/from your booth.
- All vendors will be receiving a booth map on February 21st with their designated booth location
- All vendors must bring their own tent, table and chairs and weights for the tents

- Bring plenty of inventory
- Bring sufficient cash to make change for customers
- Charge your mobile devices or bring a mobile charger
- Collect customer emails at your booth for future marketing
- We suggest offering specials, discounts and packages to encourage engagement
- Parking is limited If you have extra people coming with you to set up, please try to carpool in order to allow extra parking for shoppers/guests
